

BEHAVIOR POLICY FOR TRAVEL PROGRAMS

The Travel programs are designed to allow the campers an opportunity to have an enjoyable and safe summer while at the same time learn the importance of responsibility. The first day of camp, we will discuss the behavior policy, review the new behavior contract, learn about the new leadership-training program and provide an opportunity for the teens to meet the staff members who will be working with them.

Trip Days:

- All trips will have a designated spot where a counselor will be at all times. You will have required check-in times to meet at the designated spot. All campers are required to wear a watch and keep track of time. At check-in you report to your assigned counselor with your group. Any camper that is late to check-in will be required to remain with the counselor that sits at the check-in spot and will not be permitted to participate in the rest of the trip.
- All campers must remain in groups of at least 4 people at all times. If you do not abide by this, you will sit out with a counselor for the remainder of the trip.
- If a camper is considered a behavior problem, either in camp or on a trip, a future trip or trips may be taken away as a penalty by either the Travel Supervisors or the Camp Director. We will not permit any camper to go on trips if they have demonstrated that they cannot follow directions, are a safety hazard to themselves or others, or haven't followed camp policies.
- Camp t-shirt must be worn on all trips. This allows for campers to be easily identified and is necessary for safety. There will be no exceptions. If you do not have your shirt, you will not go on the trip.

SUGGESTED ITEMS TO BRING ON TRIP DAYS

Camp is NOT responsible for lost or stolen items.

- ◆ Waterproof watch (required)
- ◆ Camp shirt (required)
- ◆ Bagged lunch
- ◆ Backpack
- ◆ Bathing suit
- ◆ Towel
- ◆ Change of clothes
- ◆ Sweatshirt or jacket
- ◆ Money for souvenirs or food
- ◆ Change for lockers
- ◆ Plastic bag for wet items
- ◆ Hat
- ◆ Sunscreen
- ◆ Extra snack
- ◆ Extra drink (NO glass allowed)
- ◆ Sunglasses
- ◆ Proper shoes: NO flip-flops or backless sandals
- ◆ Book, walkman, travel games for bus ride (trip days only!)

We have reviewed the rules and regulations and agree to follow the directions of the Camp White Meadow staff. We also understand the penalty for any infractions of the above rules.
