WINTER BOAT STORAGE

All POA members in good standing are now given the opportunity to keep their boats in the Beach 2 parking lot over the winter. Certain rules and restrictions apply:

- 1. Current dues, past dues, and penalties must be paid in full.
- Applicants must apply at the Clubhouse office where slots will be allocated by lottery.
- Stickers must be visible at all times.
- 4. The boat must be on a trailer that is properly registered.
- 5. There will be a \$250 yearly assessment fee plus a \$100 security deposit that will be refunded if the boat is removed from the parking lot by May 14, 2015 (or when the POA docks are available if sooner than May 14, 2015).
- 6. The boat owner must sign a waiver absolving the POA of any liabilities. Liability document to be created by the White Meadow Lake attorney.
- 7. This will be done on a first come first serve basis.


