March Board Meeting

- Approved Board Meeting minutes from February 19th, 2025
- HOUSE OPS/MAINT: Revised Motion: Approved motion to hire Hilberg Contracting to replace the double doors in the ballroom that lead to the parking lot. Cost not to exceed \$9,000 and monies to come from Country Club.
- FESTIVAL DAY: FYI: Hired Mo's DJ to provide music on Festival Day at a cost of \$1,050. Money to come from Country Club.
- BAR & RENTAL: Approved motion to pay BMI for the annual music license for copyrighted music in the Gold Bar, Lounge & Ballroom for the year covering 3/1/2025 through 2/28/2026. Expense of \$1,538.40 to be charged to Country Club Line 5020-License & Permits.
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Jimmy Concrete to open the Drum Pool for the 2025 season at a cost of \$1,900. Monies to come from line 503.20 and will not overspend the line.
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Jimmy Concrete to open the Circus Pool for the 2025 season at a cost of \$1,900. Cost to be split between Beach and Camp. Beach at 25% (\$475) Camp at 75% (\$1,425). Monies to come from Beach line 503.20 and Country Club (Camp budget).
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Jimmy Concrete to close the Drum Pool at a cost of \$1,800. Monies to come from line 503.20 and will not overspend the line.
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Immy Concrete to close the Circus Pool at a cost of \$1,800. Cost to be split between Beach and Camp. Beach at 25% (\$450), Camp at 75% (\$1,350). Monies to come from Beach line 503,20 and Country Club (Camp budget). This will overspend the camp budget line.
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Chris Kleinwaks for position of Waterfront Supervisor for the 2025 season; in accordance with discussion in closed caucus. Monies to come from line 503.17.
- BOARD: Application for Household Membership (3)
- TECHNOLOGY: Approved motion for the replacement/upgrade of the Fire Alarm panel and keypads at the preschool at a cost not to exceed \$2,400. Money to come from Country Club.
- TECHNOLOGY: FYI: For the installation and monthly fees for Verizon FIOS voice and internet/data at the preschool not to exceed \$1,400 per year. This replaces the existing Optimum voice-only service which costs approximately \$1,500 a year, yielding a small annual savings. Money to come from Country
- LAKE & LAKE REC: Approved motion to contract Chemtrade to provide alum for the 2025 season at a cost not to exceed \$30,000. Monies to come from line
- LAKE & LAKE REC: Approved motion to contract Lake Management Sciences to perform applicator services for the 2025 season at a cost of \$38,200 (includes permit fees and filings). Monies to come from line 521.01.
- LAKE & LAKE REC: Approved motion to contract Princeton Hydro to perform consultant services for the 2025 season at a cost not to exceed \$35,000. Monies to come from line 522.18.
- BOARD: Approved motion to authorize Dorsey Samrau to propose a settlement to the ABC negotiation on terms amenable to White Meadow Lake as supported by the board in closed caucus.

Please complete your registration by going through all of the steps prompted.

- A 3% convenience fee will be added for payments made by credit/debit cards.
- Parent must sign a waiver of liability for bodily injuries at time of registration, as well as provide your child's birth certificate if they have not been previously enrolled.
- POA dues must be current.
- Any withdrawal of a child from a class MUST be done by a written letter to the POA office.
- If you choose to pay via cash or check, you must do so in the office within 7 business days of completing your registration or forfeit losing your spot.

For 2025 Summer Fun:

Payment is due in full at the time of registration.

For 2025-26 School Year:

- NON-REFUNDABLE \$100.00 deposit and \$25 registration fee are due at time of registration.
- Payment plans are available.
- First half of the annual tuition fee is due on or before July 26th, 2025. If the first half payment is not received, the child will not be allowed to start the first day of school.
- Second half of the annual tuition fee is due on or before November 22nd, 2025. If second half payment is not received by November 22nd, a \$50.00 late fee will be assessed.
- Monthly payments may be made via the Campsite portal as long as all tuition is paid in full no later than November 22nd, 2025. If you are paying via cash or check, you can coordinate monthly payment directly with the office. 

Swim Lessons

2025 SWIM LESSONS POLICIES

We want our classes to be a rewarding and fun experience for all. Please help us make that possible by adhering to the following policies and guidelines.

ATTENDANCE & ATTIRE: Please arrive at your child's class on time. Arriving late disrupts the flow of classes currently in session. Have swimmers ready in bathing suits and goggles. Please pick up promptly at the end of the scheduled class. Swimmers who are not toilet trained MUST have a swim diaper on with elastic at the legs and waist. If swimmers have long hair it should be tied back so it will not get in their face during lessons.

OBSERVATION: We encourage parents to be active participants in their child's learning process, but we also ask for you to keep your presence during swim lessons to a minimum. Swim Lessons are a perfect time for your child to explore their independence and confidence in a safe environment. There are certain instances where your presence can detract from your child's ability to learn. We ask that you remain along pool walls/fences and approximately 10-12 feet away on beaches.

MISSED CLASSES: Make-ups are only held for classes canceled by the POA for bad weather and if we can find a make up time. We do not offer make-up classes for classes you have missed.

2025 SWIM LESSONS CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Evaluation Date: June 14th Time TBD

Ages are a guideline, beach staff have the final approval of all levels. If you sign up for a class & we feel your child needs to be at a different level, we will work with you to find a class that works.

Parent/Child Classes: (30 months/2 ½ yrs and younger)

Mon/Wed @ Drum 9:30a-10:00a

Tues/Thurs @ Beach 1 9:30a-10:00a or @ Circus 5:00p-5:30p

Sat./Sun. @ Circus 9:30a-10:00a

Water acclimation is specially built for children who are not ready to swim without their parent(s). Throughout the session, the child transitions between the parent and instructor to allow the child to learn to listen to the instructor, become comfortable in the water, and safely explore movements in the water. A parent or guardian is required in the water with the child. Parents/Guardians will assist in teaching basic swimming skills.

2 Year Olds

Mon/Wed @ Drum 10:00a-10:30a

Tues/Thurs @ Beach 1 10:00a-10:30a or @ Circus 5:30p-6:00p

Sat./Sun. @ Circus 10:00a-10:30a

If your child is on the border for either age, please know we may choose to bump your child based on their needs when we first see them. Their ability to work independently without a parent in the water is necessary.

In this stage, students are introduced to the pool and learn skills needed for a beginner swimmer. The student also develops comfort with underwater exploration and learns to safely enter and exit the pool. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- Exploring the aquatic environment and basic swimming skills with assistance
- Developing safe water habits in a fun and encouraging environment
- Learning basic aguatic safety
- Developing basic skills for the swimmer to propel and glide through the water with assistance

3 Year Olds

Mon/Wed @ Drum 10:30a-11:00a

Tues/Thurs @ Beach 1 10:30a-11:00a or @ Circus 6:00p-6:30p

Sat./Sun. @ Circus 10:30a-11:00a

In this stage, students are introduced to the pool and learn skills needed for a beginner swimmer. The student also develops comfort with underwater exploration and learns to safely enter and exit the pool. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- Exploring the aquatic environment and basic swimming skills with assistance
- · Developing safe water habits in a fun and encouraging environment
- Learning basic aquatic safety
- Developing basic skills for the swimmer to propel and glide through the water with assistance
- Swim 5-10 feet with face in water and flat body position.

Ages 4-6

Mon/Wed @ Drum 11:00a-11:30a

Tues/Thurs @ Beach 1 11:00a-11:30a or @ Circus 6:30p-7:00p

Sat./Sun. @ Circus 11:00a-11:30a

In this stage, students learn how to swim safety for 10-15 yards. This stage also introduces rhythmic breathing and integrated arm and leg action. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- Integrating arm action, leg action, and rhythmic breathing in back and front glides
- Developing forward movement on the front and the back for 10-15 yards
- · Practicing skills and safety techniques in deep water

Ages 5 and older (swimmers that are in between lessons and swim team)

Mon/Wed @ Drum 11:30a-12:00p

Tues/Thurs @ Beach 1 11:30a-12:00p or @ Circus 7:00p-7:30p

Sat./Sun. @ Circus 11:30a-12:00p

This stage develops stroke technique in front crawl and back crawl. Water safety is reinforced through treading water. If the students are ready, instructors may introduce elementary backstroke which is the basics for breaststroke kick. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- · Developing the front crawl and back crawl 15-25 yards.
- Introducing components of the breaststroke. (elementary backstroke)
- Practicing safety techniques in deep water.


