President's Message

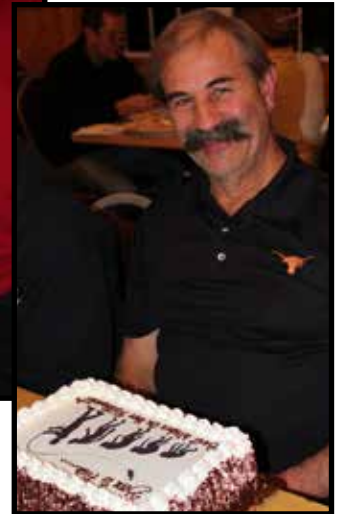

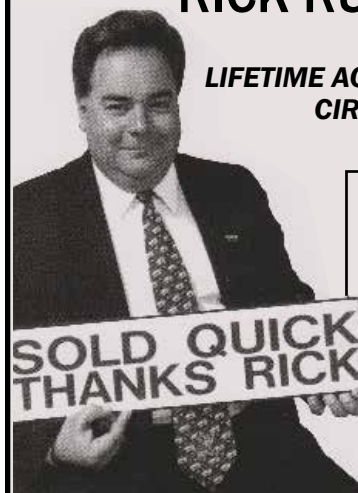


