## SYNOPSIS OF JANUARY BOARD MEETING

- Approved motion to hire Tom Harty, his electrician-Steve Maciag, & Olde World Restorations to do repairs on the clubhouse carport. Money not to exceed \$26,000 for contingencies and to come from the Equalization Fund.
- Presentation regarding playground at A Field.
- Purchased new backboards & rims from Top Hoops.com at cost of \$1,482.
- Approved motion to begin monthly transfers starting in March from Country Club Reserve Fund POA to Country Club Reserve Fund Account in the amount of \$5,000 for 10 months in 2020.
- Approved motion to pay the final bill of \$11,980 for Nisovocia LLP for costs related to the 2018 annual audit of the financial statements & preparation of the IRS form 990 & form 990T for the POA.
- Approved motion to accept D&M Fireworks to provide our fireworks display for Festival Day on July 19 in the amount of \$6,950. If necessary, rain date will be determined.
- Approved motion to revise the motion from the 10/9/2019 meeting to hire O'Neill & Sons to rip up old carpets in the Gold Lounge & Trophy Room & install new padding & carpeting at a cost not to exceed \$13,000.
- Approved motion to hire Markovski Landscaping to regrade Clubhouse lawn by bleachers/swim lanes at a cost not to exceed \$11,942.
- Approved motion to hire Solitude Lake Management for 2020 lake management services at a cost to not exceed \$42,000.
- Approved motion to hire Princeton Hydro for 2020 lake management consulting services at a cost of \$15,025.
- Approved motion to amend the prior motion of September 18, 2019 to purchase one Milton Roy Metering Pump, to adjust the cost from \$3,390.68 to \$3,505.54, which includes a delivery charge of \$114.
- Motion to retain USDA APHIS-WS to conduct wildlife services at a sum not to exceed \$6,588.
- Approved motion to hire Antonio Camacho to provide comedians for the April 4 Comedy Night, at a cost of \$3,000.

# 2020 Boat Registration

## BOAT REGISTRATION

### ALL DUES MUST BE PAID IN FULL.

Residents can register for only 1 (ONE) boat space during the first 3 weeks of registration.

(1 Dock OR 1 Rack OR 1 Steel Bar OR 1 Trailer Space)

### IMPORTANT CHANGE IN OUTSIDE LINE LOCATION!

To keep the Clubhouse entryway clear for events, the boat registration line will form in the Beach 1 parking lot area and proceed to the dam bridge where numbers will be handed out by WML Security between 9:00 am and 12:30 pm on all three registration days. First person in the physical line will receive card #1, second in line card #2, etc. Normal office business will be conducted all three days.

## BOATING RULES & REGULATIONS

### All DUES & FINES must be paid in full to obtain a White Meadow Lake 2020 Boat Tag.

- NJ DMV BOAT REGISTRATION & BOAT SAFETY CERTIFICATE are required for GAS & ELECTRIC powered boats to apply for a boat tag.
- BOAT, TRAILER & MOTOR SIZE- Boat & Trailer Length & Width are required. Maximum boat length-16 ft. Maximum Horse Power- 9.9 HP
- ONLY 2 BOATS PER RACK are allowed.
- OCCUPY DATE- Assigned space(s) must be occupied on June 8, for both dock and land.
- Spaces not occupied on June 8 may be reassigned upon a resident's request for the vacant space. The Office will contact the vacant space holder to advise them reassignment will be done, if after one week the space is not occupied. Extenuating circumstances will be considered.
- NO Waiting List will be maintained.
- Residents may SWAP SPACES after notifying the office and obtaining a replacement boat tag for the new space assigned.
- BOAT TAGS must be displayed or POA Security will padlock the boat until the proper tag is visible.
- HANDICAP accessible boat spaces will be available at all locations. A NJ state issued Handicap ID is required.
- CLEAN both your boat and trailer after it has been in another body of water before putting it back into WML.
- REMOVAL DATES- Boats & trailers must be removed before the following dates or the resident will incur a \$100 fine per boat, in addition to a \$10 penalty per boat/per day:

Dock Spaces- Monday, October 26, 2020

Land Spaces- Monday, November 16, 2020

- NJ State rules require boat operators to carry a current boat operator's license while operating power vessels.

**COMPLIANCE WITH POA RULES & REGULATIONS:**  Initial

- I agree that WML POA is not responsible for damage to any boats or trailers left on POA property.
- I agree to display the WML POA ID tag on the right rear quarter of the boat.
- I agree to store my boat in my assigned space number and in a manner to ensure no damage from my boat to POA docks and racks.
- I agree that if my boat(s) IS NOT in the assigned space (Dock or Rack) ON June 8, 2020, my space may be reassigned if the POA Office has not been notified in advance.
- I agree to notify the WML POA Office if my boat will be off POA property for a period longer than 7 days.
- I agree to remove my boat docked at POA docks no later than October 26, 2020.
- I agree to remove my boat and/or trailer from POA property no later than November 16, 2020.
- I agree that if my boat(s) or trailer is NOT removed by these dates, I will incur a \$100 fine per boat and a \$10 penalty per boat/per day. All boats and trailers on POA docks or land spaces shall have locks cut and be impounded and stored at my expense.
- I agree that failure to comply with these Rules and Regulations may result in loss of my boating privileges on White Meadow Lake.

**BEACH 1 FESTIVAL DAY KAYAK REMOVAL:**  Initial

- Must be removed by July 15th and can be returned by July 20th. If a rain date is needed for fireworks, you will be notified to remove your boat for that day.
