## **February Board Meeting**

- Approved Board Meeting minutes from January 15, 2025.
- WOMEN'S CLUB: EMAIL VOTE: Approved motion to approve the proposed budget & rates for the 2025/2026 preschool year.
- BOARD: EMAIL VOTE: Approved motion to contract with Speer Air to modify the WML Preschool furnace's ductwork at a cost up to \$4,500. Money to come from Country Club.
- BOARD: Board seat candidates O&A and voting.
- BOARD: Approved motion to approve the salary for the Community Manager position as discussed in closed caucus.
- BOARD: Approved motion to require Board members who choose to comment on Social Media posts in reference to WML committee topics to write a disclaimer before their first post or comment so the community is aware that they are speaking as a resident and their comments are not those of the Board of Directors using the following text "While I am a Board Member, this is my personal opinion and does not represent the opinion of the White Meadow Lake Board of Directors."
- ATHLETICS: FYI: Paid the remaining balance of \$1,100 towards an AED for the A-Field. This is being purchased from LifeSavers, Inc. Money to come from line 501.12 (2024 budget).
- TECHNOLOGY: FYI: Paid RingCentral, Inc \$3,057.94 for our annual service contract for our phone line service. This includes taxes and fees. Money to come from line 513.04.
- WOMEN'S CLUB: FYI: Paving North O'Nashville to perform at our Nashville Nights event at a cost of \$750. Money to come from Country Club/Scholarship.
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Geese Chasers to service all 3 beaches and Clubhouse grounds to scare geese from facilities using trained dogs. They will also pursue onto the lake using a kayak. Total cost of \$8,850 plus tax to be split between three lines. 1/3rd from Beach line 503.09, 1/3rd from Country Club and 1/3rd from Lake line 521.02. This will not overspend the Beach, Lake or Country Club lines.
- BEACH: Approved motion to purchase approximately 195 tons of beach sand from Silvi/Sahara for a total price not to exceed \$7,500. Monies to come from line 503.02 and will not overspend the line.
- BEACH: FYI: To use the "When I Work" site scheduling for lifeguards at \$2.50/user/month. Money to come from line 503.17.
- FESTIVAL DAY: FYI: Hired John To Go at a cost of \$1,396.79 to supply 10 port-a-johns for Festival Day weekend. Money to come from Country Club.
- FESTIVAL DAY: Approved motion to hire The Party Man to supply a rockwall with staffer at a cost of \$1,598. Money to come from Country Club.
- FESTIVAL DAY: FYI: Hired Tristate Timing for the Festival Day 5K event at a cost of \$1,250. Money to come from Country Club.
- FESTIVAL DAY: FYI: Hired Horizon Entertainment to supply a strolling multi talent entertainer for one of the Festival Days at a cost of \$775. Money to come from Country
- HOUSE OPS/MAINT: Approved motion to hire Hilberg Contracting to replace the double doors in the ballroom that lead to the parking lot. Cost not to exceed \$7,000 and monies to come from Country Club.
- LAKE & LAKE REC: FYI: Purchasing Trout from Musky Trout Hatcheries at a cost of \$1,350.94. Money to come from line 521.03.
- LAKE & LAKE REC: Withdrew motion to spend up to \$3,200 to contract Geese Chasers to provide geese control measures as needed through the 2025 swim season. Money to come from line 521.02.
- LAKE & LAKE REC: Approved motion to contract Princeton Hydro to perform a bathymetric survey of our lake for \$12,275. Monies to come from line 522.07.
- LAKE & LAKE REC:Princeton Hydro End Of Year Report Included
- BAR & RENTAL: FYI: Paid DMC Promotions \$849.12 for staff shirts. Money to come from Country Club line 5565.

### **Swim Lessons**

#### **2025 SWIM LESSONS POLICIES**

We want our classes to be a rewarding and fun experience for all. Please help us make that possible by adhering to the following policies and guidelines.

ATTENDANCE & ATTIRE: Please arrive at your child's class on time. Arriving late disrupts the flow of classes currently in session. Have swimmers ready in bathing suits and goggles. Please pick up promptly at the end of the scheduled class. Swimmers who are not toilet trained MUST have a swim diaper on with elastic at the legs and waist. If swimmers have long hair it should be tied back so it will not get in their face during lessons.

**OBSERVATION:** We encourage parents to be active participants in their child's learning process, but we also ask for you to keep your presence during swim lessons to a minimum. Ages are a guideline, beach staff have the final approval of all levels. If you sign up for a class & we feel your child needs to be at a different level, we will work with you to find a class that works.

Water acclimation is specially built for children who are not ready to swim without their parent(s). Throughout the session, the child transitions between the parent and instructor to allow the child to learn to listen to the instructor, become comfortable in the water, and safely explore movements in the water. A parent or guardian is required in the water with the child. Parents/Guardians will assist in teaching basic swimming skills.

#### 2 Year Olds

Mon/Wed @ Drum 10:00a-10:30a

Tues/Thurs @ Beach 1 10:00a-10:30a or @ Circus 5:30p-6:00p

Sat./Sun. @ Circus 10:00a-10:30a

If your child is on the border for either age, please know we may choose to bump your child based on their needs when we first see them. Their ability to work independently without a parent in the water is necessary.

In this stage, students are introduced to the pool and learn skills needed for a beginner swimmer. The student also develops comfort with underwater exploration and learns to safely enter and exit the pool. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- Exploring the aquatic environment and basic swimming skills with assistance
- Developing safe water habits in a fun and encouraging environment
- Learning basic aguatic safety
- Developing basic skills for the swimmer to propel and glide through the water with assistance

#### 3 Year Olds

Sat./Sun. @ Circus 10:30a-11:00a

In this stage, students are introduced to the pool and learn skills needed for a beginner swimmer. The student also develops comfort with underwater exploration and learns to safely enter and exit the pool. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- Exploring the aquatic environment and basic swimming skills with assistance
- Developing safe water habits in a fun and encouraging environment
- Learning basic aquatic safety
- Developing basic skills for the swimmer to propel and glide through the water with assistance
- Swim 5-10 feet with face in water and flat body position.

#### Ages 4-6

Mon/Wed @ Drum 11:00a-11:30a

Tues/Thurs @ Beach 1 11:00a-11:30a or @ Circus 6:30p-7:00p

Sat./Sun. @ Circus 11:00a-11:30a

In this stage, students learn how to swim safety for 10-15 yards. This stage also introduces rhythmic breathing and integrated arm and leg action. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- Integrating arm action, leg action, and rhythmic breathing in back and front glides
- Developing forward movement on the front and the back for 10-15 yards
- · Practicing skills and safety techniques in deep water

#### Ages 5 and older (swimmers that are in between lessons and swim team)

Tues/Thurs @ Beach 1 11:30a-12:00p or @ Circus 7:00p-7:30p

This stage develops stroke technique in front crawl and back crawl. Water safety is reinforced through treading water. If the students are ready, instructors may introduce elementary backstroke which is the basics for breaststroke kick. Students in this stage focus on the following:

- · Developing the front crawl and back crawl 15-25 yards.
- Introducing components of the breaststroke. (elementary backstroke)
- Practicing safety techniques in deep water.


