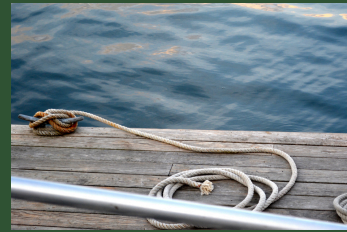

December Board Meeting

- Tabled Board Meeting minutes from November 20, 2024.
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Boyce Recreation to replace the current Beach 1 playground. Work to include but not limited to new playground structures, footings and permits. Money to come from the Country Club Reserve Fund at a cost not to exceed \$150,000.00.
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Jimmy Concrete to replace the Beach 1 concession stand deck. Cost not to exceed \$125,000.00 and money to come from the Country Club Reserve Fund.
- CAMP: Approved motion to pay for camp software from Campsite for a total up to \$15,000. Money to come from Country Club/Camp.
- BOARD: Approved motion to accept salaries as discussed in closed caucus.
- BOARD: Approved motion to accept year-end bonuses as discussed in closed caucus.
- HOUSE ACTIVITIES: Approved motion to hire Antonio Camacho for \$3,500 to provide three comedians for comedy night on April 5, 2025. Money to come from CC/ticket sales.
- WOMEN'S CLUB: Approved motion to approve \$1,550 for the ESP couple: Larry & Raven to perform on 3/29/2025. Money to come from Country Club/Scholarship based on monies from ticket sales and will not overspend the funds available.
- WOMEN'S CLUB: Approved motion to hire Any Excuse For A Party to provide two inflatables, a caricaturist and inflatable dome for the WML 3rd annual Winterfest at a cost of \$2,955.76. \$2,008.09 to come from Community Events line (\$539.09) and \$947.67 to come from Youth Events line (\$41.02). Deposits of \$500 & \$570 respectively, to come from the 2024 budget and balance to be paid from the 2025 budget.
- WOMEN'S CLUB: FYI: Hiring Party Magic Inc to supply a balloon animal artist and a strolling magic performer at a cost of \$1,195. Money to come from Community Events line 539.09-2025 budget.
- WOMEN'S CLUB: FYI: Hiring Peter Michael Marino to present a "Show Up, Kids" event on February 1, 2025 at a cost of \$1,200. Money to come from the Country Club Scholarship account/ticket sales.
- INSURANCE: Approved motion to accept the 2025 Property & Casualty Insurance proposal not to exceed \$355,000 from our current broker Jason (Jake) Schlenker CIC, CRM of Couch & Braunsdorf Insurance. Money to come from 2025 budget line 519.01.
- PLANNING: Approved motion to hire Imhoff The Diversified Group Inc. to provide an updated conditions assessment report with cost estimates for the ongoing restoration of the Clubhouse. Monies to come from line 507.00 with a cost not to exceed \$7,500.00.
- HOUSE OPS: Approved motion to hire Fino Electric to install 5 Xlerator hand dryers-model H4529 (or equivalent) in all 5 of the Clubhouse first floor bathrooms. Units to be purchased by Country Club from ULINE at a cost of \$580 each plus tax unless Fino can supply them for less. Total cost purchased and installed not to exceed \$7,000.00. Money to come from Country Club.
- LEGAL & BY-LAWS: Tabled motion to accept the revised WML Rules Enforcement Policy attached.

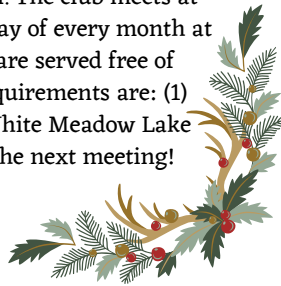
WML Friendship Club - December Recap
