

## **BEAR SAFETY**

If garbage is easily accessible, you are likely to have bears continually visit your home. Black bears and other wildlife learn very quickly, and if they find food they will continue to visit until the food source is gone.

# If you Encounter a Black Bear...

LOOK BIG Raise your hands in the air MAKE NOISE Clap your hands BACK AWAY SLOWLY Do not run or play dead

1. Secure your trash and eliminate obvious sources of food, such as pet food on decks, easy-to-reach bird feeders, or food residues left in barbecue grills.

**Reduce Encounters with Bears** 

- 2. Use certified bear-resistant garbage containers if possible. Otherwise, store all garbage in containers with tight-fighting lids and place them along the inside walls of your garage, a sturdy shed or other secure area.
- 3. Wash garbage cans frequently with a disinfectant solution to remove odors. Put out garbage on collection day not the night before.
- 4. Avoid feeding birds when bears are active. If you choose to feed birds, do so during daylight hours only and bring feeders indoors at night.
- 5. Immediately remove all food bowls used by pets fed outdoors.
- 6. Clean outdoor grills and utensils to remove food and grease residue. Store grills securely.
- 7. Do not place meat or any sweet foods in compost piles.
- 8. Remove fruit or nuts that fall from trees in your yard.
- 9. Install electric fencing as an effective way to protect crops, beehives and livestock.






