FISH TALES

I hope everyone is having a fun fishing season at WML! Besides targeting the healthy Largemouth Bass population in the lake you can try your hand at catching some toothy critters. White Meadow Lake also has a good amount of Pickerel and Walleye that swim in its waters.

These fish are fun to catch and really put up a good fight if you hook into them. Make sure that you remove the hooks carefully and handle these fish with care.

When targeting the Walleye in the summer:

I like to use swimbaits fished close to the bottom and plastic grubs rigged on a 1/8 Or 1/4 ounce jig head. You can vary the retrieve speed until the fish tell you how they want it. My buddy Geoff got his monster Walleye on a Mepps Spinner and released it after posing for this newsletter photo!

When targeting pickerel in the summer:

The one bait you can fish with and have the versatility of triggering the bite from any species of fish is the Z-Man Chatterbait. I fish this in the 3/8 ounce size and cover water quickly, right now the color white and chartreuse is really producing. It's also a bait you can fish at night on WML. The bait offers so much vibration fish can't resist and the Pickerel gobble them up like crazy!

A great investment is picking up a pair of Fish Grips to handle fish with teeth!




FUN FOR ALL




