Boat Registration

The Lake Committee continues to streamline the boat registration and boat space assignment process.

Once dues are paid in full, residents may request a boat sticker only from the office during regular business hours using the form on page 3.

This year, there are 32 more rack spaces and a new extension dock to accommodate water craft!

ALL DUES MUST BE PAID IN FULL!

Residents can register for only 1 (ONE) boat space during the first 3 weeks of registration.

(1 Dock OR 1 Rack OR 1 Steel Bar OR 1 Trailer Space)

Numbers will be handed out by WML Security between 9:00 am - 3:00 pm at the Clubhouse front door. First in the physical line will receive card #1, second card #2, etc.

NO OUTSIDE LIST WILL BE HONORED! NO EXCEPTIONS!

Land Spaces

For Kayaks, Canoes, Paddle Boards, Row Boats (No Trailers)

Saturday, March 3

Beginning at 1:00 pm, in number order, residents will proceed to the office for assignment of 1 (one) LAND space. Only boat business from 1:00 - 3:00 pm.

Dock/Water Spaces

Water Craft, excluding PONTOONS and SAILBOATS

Saturday, March 10

Beginning at 1:00 pm, in number order, residents will proceed to the office for assignment of 1 (one) WATER space. Only boat business from 1:00 - 3:00 pm.

Pontoons, Sailboats, and Trailer Spaces

Saturday, March 17

Beginning at 9:00 am, in number order, residents will proceed to the office for assignment of 1 (one) PONTOON, SAILBOAT OR TRAILER SPACE.

Normal office business will be conducted during this time.

Second Space Assignments

Starts Wednesday, March 28 • 5:00 pm

May also be done any time after that during regular office hours.

2018 Boat Registration

BOATING RULES & REGULATIONS

All DUES & FINES must be paid in full to obtain a White Meadow lake 2018 Boat Tag.

- NJ DMV BOAT REGISTRATION & BOAT SAFETY CERTIFICATE are required for GAS & ELECTRIC powered boats to apply for a boat tag.
- BOAT, TRAILER & MOTOR SIZE- Boat & Trailer Length & Width are required. Maximum boat length – 16 ft. Maximum Horse Power – 9.9 HP
- ONLY 2 BOATS PER RACK are allowed.
- OCCUPY DATE- Assigned space(s) must be occupied on June 4, for both dock and land.
- Spaces not occupied on June 4 may be reassigned upon a resident's request for the vacant space. The Office will call the vacant space holder to advise them reassignment will be done if the space is not occupied within one week of being notified. Must call for extenuating circumstances.
- NO Waiting List will be maintained.
- Residents may SWAP SPACES after notifying the office and obtaining a replacement boat tag for the new space assigned.
- BOAT TAGS must be displayed or POA Security will padlock the boat until the proper tag is visible.
- HANDICAP accessible boat spaces will be available at all locations. A NJ state issued Handicap ID is required.
- CLEAN both your boat and trailer after it has been in another body of water before putting it back into WML.
- REMOVAL DATES- Boats & trailers must be removed before the following dates or the resident will incur a \$100 fine per boat, in addition to a \$10 penalty per boat/per day:
 Dock Spaces- Monday, October 29, 2018
 Land Spaces- Monday, November 19, 2018

- NJ State rules require boat operators to carry a current boat operator's license while operating power vessels.

COMPLIANCE WITH POA RULES & REGULATIONS: _____ Initial

- I agree that WML POA is not responsible for damage to any boats or trailers left on POA property.
- I agree to display the WML POA ID tag on the right rear quarter of the boat.
- I agree to store my boat in my assigned space number.
- I agree that if my boat(s) IS NOT in the assigned space (Dock or Rack) ON June 4, 2018, my space may be reassigned if the POA Office has not been notified in advance.
- I agree to notify the WML POA Office if my boat will be off POA property for a period longer than 7 days.
- I agree to remove my boat docked at POA docks no later than October 29, 2018.
- I agree to remove my boat and/or trailer from POA property no later than November 19th, 2018.
- I agree that if my boat(s) or trailer is NOT removed by these dates, I will incur a \$100 fine per boat and a \$10 penalty per boat/per day. All boats and trailers on POA docks or land spaces shall have locks cut and be impounded and stored at my expense.
- I agree that failure to comply with these Rules and Regulations may result in loss of my boating privileges on White Meadow Lake.

- I agree to remove my kayak from Beach 1 between Thursday, July 12 through Monday, July 16 for Festival Day weekend.



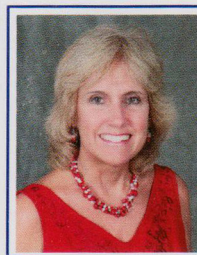
