- Board seat applicants.
- Approved motion to accept year-end bonuses as discussed in closed caucus.
- Approved motion to accept salaries as discussed in closed caucus.
- Approved motion to approve the proposed 2022-2023 budget & tuition for the WML preschool.
- Approved motion to approve the 2022 camp budget as presented.
- Approved motion to accept the 2022 property & casualty insurance proposal from our current broker Jason (Jake) Schlenker CIC, CRM of Couch & Braunsdorf Insurance for an amount not to exceed \$275,000. Money to come from the 2022 budget line 519.01.
- Purchased 5 lifeguard tubes & rope. Money to come from line 503.06 & not to exceed \$900. This will not overspend the line.


