May Board Meeting

- Approved Board Meeting minutes from April 17, 2024.
- BOARD: Auditors Report Approved motion to accept the 2023 auditor's report and financial statements for the POA and Country Club from Nisivoccia, LLP.
- BOARD: Pre-approved application of household membership (4)
- BOARD: Discussion on allowing guests to participate in classes (voga, Zumba, etc).
- BEACH: Approved motion to have the pools closed with some repairs by Jimmy Concrete at a cost of \$5,393,00 Money to come from POA lines 503.08 (\$790), 503.22 (\$1,318) and 503.20 (\$1,320) and Country Club lines 6201 (\$540), 6202 (\$960), 6203 (\$465).
- BEACH: Approved motion to hire Jimmy Concrete to open & treat the Drum Pool and repair a pump at the Circus Pool at a cost of \$4,906. \$3,427 to come from line 503.22, \$1,200 from line 503.20, \$123.75 from line 503.08 and \$155.25 from Camp/Country Club.
- BEACH: Approved motion to purchase additional pool furniture for the Drum Pool: 10 chairs/8 umbrellas/5 bases/15 umbrella table trays. Cost not to exceed \$2,500. Monies to come from line 503.09 and will not overspend the line.
- LEGAL & BY-LAWS: Defeated motion to accept the revision of Section A.10 in the Admin Guidelines to read: A.10 Family membership within the spirit of section 9 of the Constitution refers to permanent residents of White Meadow Lake. Permanent residents are defined as any individuals who have established their primary residence in that particular home. This entitlement excludes long or short-term renters or temporary occupants who do not hold permanent residency on the premises.

Note: Household Application #6 to be aligned to new A.10 "permanent resident"

- BAR & RENTAL FYI: Payment of \$1,046.50 to Ascap for music license fees. Money to come from Country Club line 5020-license & permits.
- OFFICE FYI: Renewal of our annual contract with Imperial Copy Products, Inc for maintenance of our copy machine at a cost of \$1,278.43. Money to come from line 513.09.





In late May and early June, the weather is just about perfect, the school year will be ending soon, and you will begin to see and hear a lot of splashing near the shoreline made by some large fish called carp. Although common carp and mirror carp look different, they are in fact the same species. Mirror carp are just a genetic mutation.

A very brief history

In the late 1800s, carp were imported into the United States by the U.S. Government after the European immigrants came to this country and were shocked that the waters did not contain them. The head of the United States Commission of Fish and Fisheries received thousands of letters requesting carp while he was also looking for a fish to replace the depleted waters in our country. Carp seemed to be the perfect solution since they lay many eggs, grow fast, and are seemingly unaffected by poor water conditions. At the time it sounded like a great idea. Now, not so much.

Fun to catch, but bad for our lake

According to the 2024 NJ Freshwater Fishing Digest (page 35) "Although an invasive species, Common Carp are NOT regulated as Potentially Dangerous Fish as they are already found in most waters throughout the state." I am sure you have seen the flyers posted around the lake to remove the carp from our waters. It is in our best interest to control the carp population. First, they stir up sediment which can change water chemistry and promote algal blooms when foraging in the muck for bugs and seeds. Second, they displace other fish and destroy their breeding grounds. Did you know a single carp can produce up to 2,000 offspring in a season?! They also live a long time-up to 20 years!

What can we do?

The Fishing Club has presented ideas to the Lake Committee to help control the carp population. We will be stocking bluegill sunfish in and around the carp spawning areas. One study has shown that bluegill sunfish eat carp eggs and fry (juvenile fish). We encourage our residents to fish for carp, and if you feel comfortable, humanely euthanize the fish and use the designated garbage cans for disposal. We have several other ideas to help get the carp under control and will eventually implement them.

How to fish for carp

All you need is your fishing rod and reel with 10-12 lb test line, a split shot, hook, and bait. Carp are opportunistic eaters, but many carp are caught with a single corn kernel on the hook. Cast and wait with your drag loose-when you hear your line start to sing, tighten the drag and set the hook. They are very fun to catch and they can be BIG.

One of the best parts of fishing is taking a picture of your catch and sharing it with others. With that said, please remember to be kind when someone posts on social media. Not everyone feels comfortable with the idea of disposing of a fish and they should not be chastised for returning a fish to the water (although we would prefer if the carp were not returned to our lake).

Get your Sticker!

Another important aspect of managing our fishery is to understand what fish species and size are being caught in our lake. Stop by the office to get a QR code sticker that can be placed on your tackle box or look for the QR code posted near the fishing areas. When you catch a fish, take a picture, identify the species, and estimate the length. Scan the QR code with the camera feature on your phone and answer a few questions. Remember to upload your photo-it may be put in the newsletter! Prizes will be awarded for the most participation toward the end of the year.


